On November 2, 1978, an initial joint inspection was conducted at this mine by Tom Ehmett of the Office of Surface Mining and Ron Daniels and Mary Ann Wright of the Division. Barry Grosely accompanied the inspection party around the mine site.

The inspection included the mine water discharge sediment pond and its discharge into Grassy Trail Creek where a sample was taken. It was noted that grass had been seeded on the outslopes of the mine water discharge pond. Scarifying of this area was suggested to Mr. Grosely. The Division expects a report of this seeding. The surface facility area drainage, three sediment ponds downslope of the mine yard facilities, the coal waste pile area and several discharge points into the creek and onto Kaiser-owned alfalfa fields were also checked.
