Dear Mr. Daniels:

In reply to your letter of November 14, 1979, concerning the operations of Sunnydale Mines Inc., the following is submitted as clarification:

- (1) The Sunnydale Mines operations are within the Kaiser Steel permit area and will be a part of the overall Mining and Reclamation Plan for Sunnyside.
- (2) Kaiser Steel assumes the responsibility for the activities of Sunnydale Mines for environmental degradation and violations of existing rules.
- (3) The areas being reclaimed by Sunnydale Mines will be included within the Reclamation Performance Bond by Kaiser Steel.
- (4) The waste material being reclaimed by Sunnydale Mines is being loaded into trucks at the stockpile area shown on the map submitted July 5, 1979, and trucked to point of use. To date, this has been either to the Carbon Plant of Utah Power and Light Co. or to locations in California as test shipments in the hopes of securing long term contracts. At this time no processing of the coal waste is being done at this location. In the event long term contracts are secured, a plant and siding for rail loadout may be erected within the Kaiser Steel permit area. You will be notified should this occur.
- (5) A portion of the map submitted on July 5, 1979, is enclosed restating the locations of the waste removal area and the stockpile-loadout area.
