The above operation was visited on December 5th and 6th, 1979 for the purpose of a full or complete inspection by Office of Surface Mining personnel Larry Damrau and Dennis Winterringer. The Division personnel were Ron Daniels, Joe Helfrich and Doug Stewart on December 5th. The Division personnel were Jim Smith and Doug Stewart on December 6th. They were accompanied by Lynn Huntsman, Chief Engineer of the above mentioned mine on December 5th. On December 6th they were accompanied by John Huefner, Professional Engineer, of above mentioned Sunnyside Mine Complex.

1. Tour of area was made and discussions concerning the following:
 - a. Load-out facility not satisfactorily completed, small amount of drainage waste still enters the creek.
 - b. Visible smoke from smoldering coarse refuse area, westside.
 - c. Waste of industrial nature found on coarse refuse site.
 - d. Viewed seep area at toe north and west of coarse refuse site.
 - e. Top soil pile not signed.
 - f. Sunnydale Mines, Inc. is loading out refuse from the old slurry site.
2. Three violations were written by the Office of Surface Mining as follows:
 - a. Operating without a permit.
 - b. Drainage from a disturbed area.
 - c. Waste (refuse) on fire.
