GENERAL COMMENTS

This was an inspection to followup on NOV 80-5-7-16, issued on June 30, 1980. Violation #1 had been abated by repairing the berm and upgrading the culvert.

Violation #2 had not been terminated as of this inspection. A Cessation Order for failure to abate was issued on September 16. Mr. Huefner notified the Denver OSM office on September 17 that abatement had taken place by 1:45 p.m. on September 17. During a September 18 inspection of the cited area, I determined that abatement as required had taken place. The Cessation Order was terminated.

Violation #3 was terminated on September 16. The cited bridge was covered.

Violation #4 was terminated based on preliminary submission of a permit modification request by Mr. Huefner to the Utah DOGM and OSM.

Abatement dates for violation #5, 6, and 7 were September 29, 1980. As of this inspection, they had not yet been abated.

The State Health approval required by violation #8 had been obtained, and the violation terminated. This approval was obtained by the operator with a show of good faith, and said points in the assessment should apply.

Two Utah State violations issued June 1980 had not been abated by the September 16 inspection. Two Cease Orders were issued by the State for failure to abate these violations. The orders were terminated when the violations were abated on September 18.
