I have reviewed the February 25, 1981 Kaiser report on using coarse refuse for road base material. The report indicates that sediment control measures such as lateral ditches and fabric silt fences will be implemented. The report also includes Dr. Wingets evaluation that the impacts from the road bed material would probably be negligible compared with natural limiting factors.

Therefore we are not opposed to the use of coarse refuse for road base where adequate sediment control measures are provided.
