

RE: Sunnyside Mine

The Sunnyside Complex was visited on May 21, 1981, by Joe Helfrich and Sandy Pruitt from the Division and Robbie Jones, bonding specialist, Bill Young, engineer, Mike Wong, engineer, John Montgomery, hydrologist and Al Riebau, lead reviewer, from the Office of Surface Mining. State and federal employees were accompanied by John Huefner, Hon Lee and Marcia Wolfe, representatives from the Sunnyside Complex. The purpose of the visit was to acquaint federal employees with the surface facilities and layout of the Sunnyside Mine Complex.

During the field tour, the following deficiencies were noted throughout the surface facilities:

- A. Runoff at the material storage yard.
- B. Topsoil delineation needed in the refuse disposal area.
- C. Extensive erosion on the downslope of the tippie stockpile around the train tunnel.
- D. The haul road permitted to use coarse refuse as a base material presently does not comply with stipulations set forth by the Board.
- E. The drilling activity near the coarse refuse dump into existing shale formations.
- F. Erosion on downslopes of slurry embankments, also mixing of slurry and coal waste with alleged topsoil.
- G. All roads in the slurry and coarse refuse areas are constructed of coarse refuse. Proper drainage on these roads is questionable.
- H. A dam was constructed across an existing drainage at the confluence of Water and Fan canyons.

5. Enter fees for the services requested in the appropriate spaces on the front of this receipt. If receipts requested, check the applicable blocks in Item 1 of Form 3811.
6. Save this receipt and present it if you make inquiry.
