
Dear Mr. Lawrence,

The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (DOGM) has reviewed Sunnydale Mine's request to construct a railroad spur within the disturbed area utilized by Sunnydale at the Kaiser Steel's Sunnyside Mine.

After staff discussion with Mr. John Huefner of Kaiser Steel, it is evident that Kaiser would be liable for the disturbance created within this area, and therefore must either accept the proposed spur as part of their mine permit disturbance or negotiate the responsibility with Sunnydale. A letter addressing the liability must be submitted to DOGM prior to construction of the spur.

Since there will be no new disturbance created by this spur DOGM sees no additional cause to hold up the approval. Therefore, upon receipt of a notice of liability from the appropriate party, the Division will issue a permit for construction.
