Dear John:

Thank you for your letter of June 4, 1982 relative to Division correspondence, particularly memos. The Division considers memos to be official inspection reports, and also to be records of other significant events which become a permanent part of each mine file. Our purpose in forwarding the memos to you is to: 1) keep you informed of the inspection results (i.e., observations, actions, results, recommendations, etc.), 2) expedite the flow of information, and 3) reduce the amount of paperwork being generated while getting the necessary work performed.

I would ask that you respond to the February 9, 1982 Division memo attached to Joe's letter of March 2, 1982 as an official request so that we can eliminate the specific hydrologic problems which are noted in the memo.

Our goal is to achieve a cooperative working relationship with the coal mining industry and to continue developing our mineral resources, while protecting our public and other natural resources.

Henceforth, I have instructed my staff to utilize letters as the official form of communication when requesting any action to be taken, outside that of an NAOC, or CO, which are to be considered official requests for action in and of themselves.

Your concern is greatly appreciated, and I hope that this has clarified the situation for you. Please call me at any time if you have any questions.
