Note: This violation was issued on April 21, 1982 for failure to abate NOV No. N82-4-3-3, part 1 of 3. The original NOV (N82-4-3-3) was issued on March 2, 1982. Mr. Huefner indicated that his failure to abate was caused by hi waiting for the Division to hold an assessment conference on N82-4-3-3. The assessment conference was held on May 6, 1982 and the area was visited in the field. At the time of the assessment conference, the violation had been abated in full. It is the assessment officer's opinion that an extension should have been issued to allow the conference to take place since the maximum abatement period (90 days) had not transpired. In addition, no imminent environmental harm was taking place or about to take place. The violation is vacated.
