Dear John:

The USFWS has completed its survey of the powerlines at the Sunnyside Mine as mentioned in my March 8, 1982 letter to Mr. John Huefner.

Although problem sections were identified, they are not within the jurisdiction of Kaiser Steel Corporation. After reviewing the results of the surveys, the Division will follow the recommendation of the USFWS and not require Kaiser to modify any of the existing poles at the Sunnyside Mine at this time. However, should a problem arise in the future, Kaiser Steel Corporation may be required to modify the power poles in the problem area(s).

The time extension requested for the submittal of the baseline vegetation study until May 24, 1982, is hereby granted. However, let me point out that further extensions may delay the review of your permit application.
