Dear Mr. Daniels:

Kaiser Steel has one county road crossing the mine permit area which is maintained with public funds and is used by the public for access to the general area. Use of the road by the public and other companies is significantly higher than Kaiser Steels use of the road. Activities supported by the road other than coal mining are grazing, hunting, fishing, camping, oil and gas exploration, tar sands exploration, City of Sunnyside and East Carbon water supply, Mountain Bell Telephone relay station and other microwave relay stations, logging and general recreation. The road is the primary access to over a million acres of public and private land.

Kaiser Steel feels that further effort by the Division to prove that the road is a coal haul road (coal has never been hauled on the road) would be a waste of public funds. Kaiser therefore requests that the issue be dropped by the Division.
