As per your letter of August 11, 1983 the following changes are to be made in the plan:

- 1- The freeboard in ditches D1-D6 is to be .3 feet as per UMC 817.43(f)(2). The effective depth on all the ditches will increase by .11 feet.
- 2- Rip-rap at the outlet of the ponds will be 12 inch minus. Rip-rap at the inlet and outlet of the culverts and at the pond inlets will be 6 inch minus.
- 3- All stipulations in the State Board of Health approval letter will be adhered to.
- 4- All topsoil will be saved as per the January 17, 1983 letter to Barton Kale.
