Recent review of the No.2 Canyon Wash stockpile belt crossover by the Division's reclamation officer Barton Kale has rendered the approved coal dust monitoring plan at this site obsolete. Now action must be taken to prevent potential coal dust from encountering the No.2 Canyon Wash. A plan to implement this action is being submitted to you now for your approval. Details of the plan are as follows:

- 1- Kaiser Steel will install pre-fabricated 16-gauge galvanized steel skirts on the bottom of the stockpile conveyor above No.2 Canyon Wash. (Dwg. SK-1)
- 2- The skirt sections will be lap-jointed and will cover between the east and west supporting bents (approximately 100 feet). (Dwg. SK-2)
- 3- Installation will be achieved by using a boom-crane and utility truck. No environmental disturbance to the No.2 Canyon Wash area will occur by use of this far-reaching equipment.
- 4- After skirt installation and the subsequent transportation of coal on the stockpile belt, the interior of the skirted span will be periodically washed by water and will drain to the east bent? where it will then encounter the disturbed area drainage, which flows into the coal slurry ditch.

Because of fluctuating coal demand, it will be in the best interest to implement and complete this plan as soon as possible. Your prompt response will be appreciated.
