The Division will review Kaiser Steel's request to leave roads and bridges as part of the post mining land use upon completion of mining. However, the sizing requirements for hydrologic structures (i.e. culverts and bridges) must be met to pass a 100 year - 24 hour event, pursuant to UMC 817.44(b)(2).

Please submit calculations on all hydrologic structures to remain with the roads to assure that the design is adequate to meet the 100 yr-24 hour event requirement.
