Dear Mr. Hagen:

The Division has been in contact with Kaiser Steel Corp. in regard to the four-part 10-Day Notice cited above. Our intended course of action to respond to this notice is to conduct a complete inspection of the Sunnyside Complex during the week of December 5, 1983 and take any appropriate enforcement action.

Just to update you of the results of our conversations with Kaiser thus far; the company informs our office that all situations pointed out in the notice have been corrected except those problems in water canyon where winter snows have begun to accumulate, making access and viewing the problem difficult.

There appears to be a difference of opinion between our respective agencies on the requirement to maintain sediment control on the class III access road in water Canyon. Without viewing the problem area which is the subject of the 10-day notice, we cannot make a fully informed judgement and our discussion of the problem may have to be continued next spring.

Subsequent to our complete inspection the week of December 5, 1983 you will be sent an inspection report and copies of any issued notices of violation.

Please let us know if this intended action satisfies the 10-day notice requirements.
