After reviewing your revised plans and maps submitted on August 22, 1983, any concerns which the Division has expressed have been addressed in Kaiser Steel's letter of August 19, 1983. The Division will, therefore, grant approval for construction of Old Refuse Road Sediment Pond.

Verbal approval was given Kaiser on August 24, 1983 to begin construction of this sediment pond. At that time, all of the Division's concerns had been addressed and Kaiser had received approval from the State Board of Health and had agreed to the terms of that approval letter. Due to the massive workloads, the Division has had no time to follow through with a formal approval letter. This letter will hopefully fill this void.
