A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site on June 20, 1984, by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Doug Pearce of Kaiser Steel.

The twin Shafts and Manshaft areas were viewed with no major problems. Grade work had been done on the upper road so it is now driveable. Some of the straw bales at the Manshaft need replacing along the guard rail. These were discussed with the operator.

Slaughter Canyon was viewed and determined that it was progressing well. Sagebrush transplants are looking good as are the grasses that have come up this year. The area at the bottom has a little more difficulty in establishing itself because of its darker soil material (some residue coal refuse). Where the straw is stable the grass has taken.
