Dear Mr. Pearce:

The Division is in receipt of the May 22, 1984 request by Kaiser Steel Corporation to revise the current interim permit through the addition of a portion of the federal B Canyon Lease. At this time, it is not possible for the Division or the Office of Surface Mining to process a revision of this nature until Kaiser Steel Corporation has obtained approval of its Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) for the Sunnyside Mines under the permanent program. Currently, the Division, through its contractor, is completing the final Technical Analysis (TA). Because the review process is in the final stages, it is not possible to modify the existing MRP to incorporate addition of another lease.

It is suggested that Kaiser submit this revision for consideration immediately after final approval under the permanent program.
