On October 10, 1985, we received a package of maps and pages for the subject PAP. This information was forwarded with your transmittal letter dated October 7, 1985, identified as, "09/20/85 UT DOGM transmittal of revisions for mining and reclamation plan." Your letter also stated the PAP application is in the final stages of preparation for a decision and asked for a final concurrence letter from this office with any conditions necessary for final action on the mining plan.

Our review of the maps and pages, referred to above, did not identify any conflicts with the resource recovery and protection plan (R2P2) part of the subject PAP which we recommended for approval in our memorandum dated May 17, 1985.

The R2P2, as now amended, on file in this office is in compliance with 43 CFR 3482.1(c) rules and regulations. The proposed coal recovery procedures should safely obtain maximum recovery of the resource using the technology and mining equipment proposed in the plan.

Within the limits of our authority we concur with the Sunnyside mine R2P2, as amended, now on file in this office and recommend that it be included as an integral part of the subject PAP.
