Re: Coarse Refuse Toe Pond Response  
Sunnyside Mines, ACT/007/007

Attached, as per your request of November 10, are three copies of the revised plan for the Coarse Refuse Toe Pond -- new location.

The plan specifies that grouted riprap will be used for erosion protection in appropriate locations. Since this riprap acts as a unit and precludes rolling of the rock, a median stone diameter is not necessary. Modifications to the plan to accommodate Items 2 and 3 of your letter have been made. Kaiser Coal, as requested in Item 4, commits to submitting twelve more copies upon approval of the plan. This revised plan is in a format consistent with insertion into the approved Sunnyside Plan: Appendix III-1, Item 1, and Plate III-5.

A change to previously submitted plans is the inclusion of an alternate borrow area east of the railroad tracks. Should this borrow area be utilized, environmental effects resulting from the construction of this pond should be reduced, thereby reducing the attendant reclamation requirements. Your approval of the alternate borrow area is anticipated. David Lof has observed and is familiar with this area.
