The road is used year round to transport men, materials, and too service mine ventilation facilities in Fan and Water Canyons located on Kaiser Coal Corporation's fee land in Sections 4 and 9, R.14 E. T.15 S. SLBM. The majority of the road was constructed when the mine portals were started in the 1920's. In 1978 the access roadway to the north was reconstructed and 1,150 feet of new road was made on BLM land. Road specifications are: Length - 7,100 feet; Width - 30 feet; Average grade - 3.8%; Maximum grade 7.3%; Surfacing - local earth fill. A 100 foot right of way is shown on a attached map and contains 15.04 acres. Life of the road is expected to be 25 years.




