Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Field Operations (WFO), has received the February 11, 1987, Kaiser Coal Corporation's submittal of an amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/007/007-87B for the Sunnyside mine. This amendment is to suspend flocculant treatment of water draining from the coarse refuse toe seep. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18. Based on the review of the submittal, OSMRE concurs with the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGM's) decision to approve the submittal as indicated in DOGM's letter dated March 27, 1987, and the Federal permit UT-014-6, dated January, 1986, is revised accordingly.
