Dear Mr. Braxton:

As you are no doubt aware, on February 13, 1987, Kaiser Coal Corporation filed Chapter 11 bankruptcy. Kaiser is now a ward of the court and must abide by its requirements. One of these requirements is that the retention of consultants be approved by the court prior to the performance of work.

Ms. Susan Hasenjager has performed basically all soils and vegetation work for Kaiser for the last two years. Immediately prior to the Chapter 11 filing, she was asked to prepare the vegetation portion of the annual reports for each property. As a consultant, her retention is now a matter for the court and has not, as yet, been approved. Although it is assumed that court approval will soon be granted, she will be unable to perform the necessary tasks in time to submit them to the Division on March 31. To further complicate matters, Ms. Hasenjager has in her possession the data necessary to formulate the reports.

For the mentioned reasons, Kaiser requests an extension until May 18, 1987, for submittal of the vegetation section of the subject reports. This is the date which Ms. Hasenjager indicates she is capable of meeting. If necessary, it may be possible to provide some limited interim information which the Division may request. It is not anticipated that other sections of the annual reports will be delayed.
