The temporary industrial waste disposal proposal is acceptable. The materials are being placed and stored in a controlled manner in a designated portion of the permit area.

There are some minor deficiencies. The non-coal waste pile is identified on Plate III-1A (Drawing C4-0161). It is difficult to identify the area from that drawing, that is, Section, Township, and Range. This area should be on an easily identifiable and "locatable" map. Areas should be clearly marked with existing structures, such as sediment ponds. The area, #2 Canyon, should also be identified on the map.
