I wrote NOV-N-87-20-1-1 on June 29, 1987 and gave it to my permit supervisor, John Whitehead, on that same date (copy attached). This Notice of Violation resulted from the fact that the Division has not received an acceptable form of bond in the amount of \$8,676,773.00 from Kaiser Coal Corporation.

This bond submittal was prompted by a letter from Dianne R. Nielson to Jeff Collins dated March 26, 1987, requesting an alternate form of bond within 90 days of receipt of that letter because the self-bond is not acceptable.

Failure to comply with the above requirements may result in the issuance of a stop-work order and/or a civil penalty.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. N 87-20-1-1

Violation No. 1 of 1

Nature of violation

UMC ~~800~~ 800.23 (G)

The operator failed to post an alternative form of bond in the combined amount of \$8,676,773 (for all three operations).

Provisions of act, regulations or permit violated

UMC 800.23 (G)

The operator was notified by certified mail that an alternative form of bond must be posted within 90 days of the receipt of this letter. (Letter sent March 26, 1987).

Portion of operation to which notice applies

All three of the operations, Sunnyside, Horse Canyon and Wellington are affected.

Remedial action required (including any interim steps)

An alternative form of bond is still required.

Abatement time (including interim steps)

An alternative form of bond in the amount of \$8,676,773 is required by July 6, 1987.
