RE: Classification of Coarse Refuse Expansion, Kaiser Coal Corporation, Sunnyside Mine, ACT/007/007, File #2, Carbon County, Utah

This memo formalizes the March 31, 1987 discussions between Lowell Braxton, Wayne Hedberg, and John Whitehead regarding the classification of a proposed permit change to expand the Coarse Refuse Disposal Area at Kaiser's Sunnyside Mine.

Utilizing a map from the proposed change, the acreage outside of the existing permit area is 8.4 acres. Since the approved Sunnyside permit acreage exceeds 14,000 acres, this falls within the maximum Incidental Boundary Change allowable for Sunnyside (10 acres).

The new disturbance within the permit area that is a part of the expansion is 38 acres. This is less than the 15 percent of the current disturbed acreage of 287 acres. Thus, the proposed change is not a significant permit revision as defined by SMC 788.12(d)(1).

The proposed change will be classified as an Incidental Boundary Change and Amendment (IBC/Amendment).
