Dear Mr. Grossley:

Re: Revision in Seed Mix for 1987 Planting, Kaiser Coal Corporation, Sunnyside Mine, ACT/007/007, Carbon County, Utah

This is to confirm the Division's approval to substitute Stipa comata (needle & thread grass) with Elymus cinereus (Great Basin wildrye) at a rate of 3.0 pounds pure live seed (PLS)/acre (broadcast rate) and to substitute Petalostemon purpureum (purple prairieclover) and Solidago canadensis (Canada goldenrod) with Linum lewisii (lewis flax) at a rate of 1.0 pound PLS/acre (broadcast rate) for the 1987 seeding at the Sunnyside Mine. As discussed with you on the phone, all other species listed on Table III-18 (the seed mix to be used) are available and should be used. These substitutions could be made permanent by making a written request and revising Table III-18.

The Division would appreciate notification two-to-three days prior to seeding so that if our schedules allow, we could make a site visit during revegetation activities.
