Re: Conditional Approval, CRT Pond Designs, Kaiser Coal Corporation, Sunnyside Mines, ACT/007/007-86B, Folder #3 & #4, Carbon County, Utah

Information contained in your letter received by the Division on December 5, 1986 has been reviewed by Division Hydrologist Jim Fricke and Soils Specialist Dan Duce. Plans and designs for the CRT pond are complete and adequate. Approval with the following conditions is hereby granted.

1. The depth dimension of the splash basin to be installed for the pond outlet will be 1.5 ft.
2. If the alternative borrow area east of the railroad tracks is used, it will be permanently reclaimed by December 31, 1988 if not included in an approved permit change to expand the coarse refuse area by that time.
3. The Coarse Refuse Toe sediment pond construction will be completed no later than June 1, 1987.

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Please forward to the Division by January 19, 1987,  
Kaiser's written commitment to the above noted conditions.  
Twelve (12) more copies of the approved plan must be  
submitted to the Division no later than February 27, 1987.

Thank you for your cooperation in completing this  
permitting issue.
