RE: Temporary Cessation of Operations, Kaiser Coal Corporation, Sunnyside Mines, ACT/007/007, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

## Synopsis

On October 24, 1988 the operator responded to the August 24, 1988 Division request for temporary cessation of operations information. The Division requested information pursuant to UMC 817.131.

## Analysis

The operator submitted a current mine workings map and current surface facilities map. Additionally, contemporaneous reclamation and final reclamation activities were described. The operator will continue to sample all water monitoring stations according to the approved plan.

Portals that are not currently being used to access the mine are anticipated to be sealed or secured with gates. The No. 2 Mine is still being evaluated for salvage operations.

Vegetation and subsidence monitoring will be conducted in 1989.

## Recommendation

The Division should approve the request for temporary cessation of operations.
