The applicant may wish to contact Susan D. Hasenjager, who reportedly sampled a new pinyon-juniper/grass reference area for Kaiser Coal Corporation. If available, that data would be acceptable to the Division. Otherwise, Sunnyside Fuels Corporation will please arrange with the Division for approval of another reference area. Vegetation sampling of the new reference area will be required in July of 1989. Subsequently, the applicant will please replace all outdated material in Chapter 9 with new material. This includes text, tables and figures.
