Synopsis

Review of the 1988 Subsidence Monitoring submittal indicates the operator has installed and monitored stations along Bear Canyon and Whitmore Canyon according to the approved Subsidence Monitoring Plan.

Plate III-1, 2 of 3, was also submitted and locates all subsidence monitoring stations.

Data indicate relatively little (less than 2.0 feet) vertical movement has occurred in either Bear Canyon or Whitmore Canyon. Accordingly, the potential for mining-induced impacts to surface land use and wildlife or water resources appears minimal.

Conculsion

The operator is in compliance with the approved subsidence monitoring plan.
