Re: Monitoring of Whitmore Pond 002B

Per our phone conversation on 12-4-89, SRS will sample for the parameters listed on the Discharge Monitoring Report provided by the Bureau of Water Pollution and EPA after the pond is put into service and until it stabilizes.

After it becomes evident that the Whitmore Pond 002B has stabilized, baseline sampling will commence on a weekly basis. As discussed, a suite of samples will be collected for four weeks at which time SRS will request a change of baseline sampling on a weekly basis to operational sampling on a monthly basis.
