Dear Mr. Monson:

Re: Cessation Orders 89-25-1-1 and 89-25-2-1 and Plan
for Construction of a Second Pond at Whitmore

SRS is submitting, with this letter, a plan for construction of a second pond at the 002 discharge area for approval by the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining and the Department of Health.

The measures of the Stream Restoration Plan submitted on May 2, 1989, are completed as follows:

1. SRS is complying with the continued sampling of 002 discharge.
2. A flocculent system is in place, and an adequate supply of flocculent is on hand.
3. SRS is waiting for approval to remove the sediment-control structures in the Grassy Trail Creek per our meeting on June 15. It is anticipated the structures on the discharge will remain in place until it is determined these sediment-control structures are no longer needed.
4. The steam inventory is complete. Per Richard Baumann's verbal report in the meeting of June 15, 1989, SRS should receive the written report by June 30.
5. The fisheries are being restored through natural migration of aquatic life, as per Richard Baumann's report.
6. SRS is continually looking at means to improve the underground mine dewatering system. Presently, a new sump is being installed adjacent to #1 Slope at 20th Right. This should provide additional settling capacity prior to water being pumped to the main sump.

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
7. SRS has determined that the most efficient and cost-effective means to clean out the Whitmore Pond is construction of a second pond at the 002. Diverting the discharge to the SSSF Pond is not a safe, effective means of dewatering the mine.

We are submitting the plan for construction of the second pond with this letter for approval by the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining and the Department of Health.

8. SRS continues to work with the city of Sunnyside on control of the city lines.

SRS looks forward to your prompt action on the approval of the plan for construction of the second pond at Whitmore.
