Re: Reactivation of 002 Discharge Point

Mr. Rick Smith with DOGM was also notified on May 17, 1989, prior to the reactivation of the 002 Discharge Point. It is SRS's understanding that both agencies agreed that this step is necessary to protect the mining operations.
