## Synopsis and Proposal

There are ten buildings that were designated as "permanent" in the reclamation cost estimate with the justification that they would be accepted as permanent by Sunnyside City Council. A legal opinion by the Assistant Attorney General required that more liability information must be submitted by Sunnyside Reclamation and Salvage, Inc. (SRS) for the Division to make appropriate findings.

The October 31, 1989 submittal revised the text and reclamation cost estimate to demolish the buildings.

## Recommendation

The amendment to designate the ten buildings as permanent has been changed and essentially withdrawn. The reclamation cost estimate for the demolition of the ten buildings is adequate.
