Synopsis and Proposal

There are ten buildings that were designated as being accepted by the Sunnyside City Council when Sunnyside Reclamation and Salvage, Inc. (SRS) goes into reclamation, per a letter from Sunnyside City Corporation (letter dated June 26, 1989). A request for a legal opinion regarding the adequacy of this letter to cover liabilities was dated July 17, 1989. On August 15, 1989, Barbara W. Roberts, Assistant Attorney General, rendered her opinion that the Division must be provided with more liability information. A letter to Mr. William P. Balaz of SRS from Richard V. Smith (dated August 16, 1989) requested specific information be submitted for the Division to derive appropriate findings for the ten buildings.

Per my telephone conversation on October 5, 1989 with Mr. Balaz, he stated there has been no resolution concerning the building liability for Sunnyside City Corporation.

Recommendation

Mr. Balaz committed to revise the bond estimate as well as appropriate sections of the text reflecting that the ten buildings will be permanent. He committed to submit this information by October 16, 1989.
