On September 6, 1989, I received an anonymous complaint from a resident of Sunnyside, Utah, regarding the amount of coal dust that is being generated at the Sunnyside Mine. Evidently, residents in the area have previously presented their complaints to Sunnyside Reclamation and Salvage, Inc. management, but have not received a satisfactory response.

I plan to inspect the mine site on Friday, September 8, 1989, to ascertain whether or not air quality standards are being met. I will submit a report following my inspection.
