Dear Mr. Balaz:

This has reference to the Notice of Violation 89-26-16-1 particularly as it relates to flows in Grassy Trail Creek. The violation resulted when emulsion fluid was discharged into Grassy Trail on March 25, 1989. The fluid consists of 5% oil and 95% water. The main interest concerning this violation centered on Grassy Trail Creek from the Sunnyside Park to Pole Canyon (Whitmore Mine Water Pond). However, I also inspected Grassy Trail Creek where it intersects Utah Highway I-23. This was done and reported on March 28, 29, & 30 and noted as no flow nor any sign of oil emulsion. Also, other no flow observations were made at the same location and noted in my field book.

The water below Sunnyside Park was being utilized to irrigate crops, primarily alfalfa hay.
