Re: Denial of Request for Incidental Boundary Change, Carbon County
Lease for No. 1 Slope, Kaiser Coal Corporation, Sunnyside Mines,
ACT/007/007, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The Division is unable to approve the submitted request dated March 20, 1989, for an Incidental Boundary Change (IBC). Please be aware that IBCs may not exceed ten acres during a five-year permit term. Requests that exceed ten acres may be classified and reviewed as Significant Revisions. Accordingly, the additional request for an IBC at Sunnyside Mines must account for the area of land encompassed by the IBC approved October 4, 1988. More specifically, the submitted request for an IBC may not exceed 9.83 acres during this permit term.

You should also be aware that the Division cannot act on permitting actions initiated by Sunnyside Reclamation and Salvage until such time as the permit transfer has been formally approved.


Dear Mr. Smith:

Sunnyside Reclamation and Salvage is submitting a request for an incidental boundary change (IBC) to allow development of the No. 1 Main Slopes for longwall panel No. 22 Left and any subsequent panels. The surface and minerals on the NE 1/4 of Section 21, T14S, R14E, SLB&M, Utah, are controlled by Carbon County, Utah. A lease has been applied for and SRS will file proof of lease and rights to enter when the lease is finalized. The lease area and IBC area are illustrated on the enclosed Drawing No's. A4-0224 and A1-0225.

The request for the IBC is being made to allow continued development of the Sunnyside Mines reserves and provide employment in the area.

The land involved in the incidental boundary change is 24.24 acres of 160 acres in the Carbon County lease. The IBC is 0.17 percent of the 14,065 acres within the permit boundary. The boundary description for the incidental boundary change is described below:

Beginning at a point that bears N45°18'47"E, 3750.81 ft. from the SW Corner of Section 21:
thence S89°11'45"E, 800 ft.;
