Re: 1989 Vegetation Annual Report


Per your letter dated July 31, 1990, and our phone conversation thereafter, we agree that a vegetation report for 1989 was not conducted. The Railcut Pond, New Coarse Refuse Pond, Borrow Area pond, Old SSF Pond Access Road, and the 002B Pond that were seeded in November, 1989, show vegetation growth.

Sunnyside Coal Company has the 1990 Annual Vegetation Study planned and will submit the results in the 1990 Annual Report. Future vegetation studies will be conducted on an annual basis and reported in the annual report for that year.

The Sacco Flats Test Plot will also be studied and a rehabilitation plan will be submitted for your approval.
