Re: As-Built Drawings For 002A And 002B Mine Water Ponds

Per our phone conversation, I have enclosed the as-built drawings for the 002A and 002B Mine Water Ponds. The changes to the 002A Pond are as follows:

- Installation Of A Spreader Bar On The Inlet Pipe
- Proposed Installation Of A Valve On The Outlet Pipe
- Series Connection Pipe To The 002B Pond

The only change to the 002B Pond is the proposed installation of a valve on the outlet pipe.

Cleaning of the 002A Pond is completed and awaits approval of the outlet valve installation before being reactivated. I have enclosed a detailed drawing of the valves to be used on the 002A and 002B outlet pipes. The only difference in the valves will be their size. The valve is designed so it can be mounted on the convoluted metal pipe from both discharges.
