Re: Change From Baseline To Operational Water Monitoring At
Sampling Points WR-1, WR-2, PC-1, DH86-1, And DH86-2

In a letter dated February 15, 1991, Sunnyside Coal Company requested that Sampling Points WR-1, WR-2, PC-1, DH86-1, and DH86-2 be changed from baseline to operational status. The Division's response dated March 6, 1991, requested more information be submitted for DH86-2 for 1990 or an appropriate reason given.

Baseline data for DH86-2 was submitted for 1987, 1988, and 1989. DH86-2 was not monitored in 1990 because Sunnyside Coal no longer had right of access to the B and C Canyon area. Sufficient baseline data was obtained prior to 1990; and if right of access is regained to the B and C Canyon area, then monitoring of DH86-2 will resume for operational parameters.

In addition, DH86-1 and DH86-2 are not associated with the Sunnyside Permit but were established for the B Canyon Permit Application.
