In response to our phone conversation this morning, I would like to confirm Sunnyside Coal Company's commitment to the following:

1. Deliver to you seven copies of the Pond Division Order to insert as a whole in the existing permit.
2. Submit a revised Permit Amendment for the No. 2 Canyon Wash for dust prevention.
3. Submit a revised Permit Amendment for one ASCA area and one New Drainage Plan for Lower No. 2 Canyon Pond. *→ pipe to pond ←*
4. Prepare and submit a Permit Amendment to remove SCA's area from our permit upon your approval of SCA's permit.
5. Submit a new Chapter 1 (Legal).
6. Submit an amendment revising Chapter VIII to include the 1988 Soils Survey of Carbon Area, Utah.
7. Submit as-built drawings of the drainage of the Rail Loop area and Clear Water Pond Spillway.

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We are also working on the abatement of two NOV's -- Coarse Refuse Contemporaneous Reclamation and the drainage ditch along the Prep. Plant to the SSSF Pond.

Cooperation with the appropriate people working on SCA's permit is getting better such that we are involved to a greater extent than in the past. I have pledged our cooperation to them.

The amendment removing SCA's area from our permit will also remove two non-mined shadow areas from the existing PAP. We will also add a significant area in Section 16 (Geneva-State Lease) for the last longwall panels of the mine.

Patrick Collins' report on vegetation is being delayed due to some other commitments; although, the field work is done. Our verbal communication with him indicates that two- and four-foot soil substitute appears to sustain suitable revegetation and recommendations for the thinner soil substitute test areas and for the test plot in general.

Thus, progress on our new PAP has accordingly not progressed directly. With this in mind, we deferentially ask for an extension for this resubmission.
