RE: Amendment to Classify All Roads in Response to Notice of Violation (NOV) N93-40-5-9 (5 of 9), Sunnyside Coal Company, Sunnyside Mine, ACT/007/007-93T, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

SYNOPSIS

The permittee submitted this amendment for Division approval on September 15, 1993.

By this amendment, the permittee seeks to reclassify all of the roads as either primary or ancillary in order to abate Notice of Violation (NOV) N93-40-5-9, Violation 5 of 9.

ANALYSIS

I initially approved this amendment on October 7, 1993. After reviewing the application, however, Division Senior Engineer Randy Harden felt that all roads that were to remain through the entire life of the mine should be classified as primary roads. Harden also recommended that SCC be required to make that part of its road plan which falls within the SCA site match with SCA's road plan, since SCC and SCA are still mutually responsible for the SCA site.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that this amendment application be rejected and that the permittee be required to correct its road plan in accordance with the above analysis.
