Dear Mr. Fielder:

The above-noted abatement that addressed part 1 of 2 of the Federal Violation has been reviewed by the Division and determined that the amendment meets the requirements of R645-301-741, R645-301-742.100 and R645-301-742.200. The criteria for these BTCA areas which do not drain to sediment ponds are considered small and treatable by alternative BTCA technologies.

Calculations for the Central Metering Station and the Twin Shafts Mine Water Pond Topsoil Pile were reviewed. Based on the calculations submitted and the results of those calculations, it has been determined that the Central Metering Station and the Twin Shafts Mine Water Pond Topsoil Pile are considered BTCA areas and meet the Division Criteria for BTCA areas. Additional verbiage, however, needs to be incorporated into the PAP that states "all BTCA structures will be monitored and maintained to meet all applicable state and federal effluent limits."


In regards to the sediment control for the powerline corridor, included as a portion of the abatement plan for part 2 of 2, the Division has made a determination that siltation structures and alternative sediment control structures are not necessary to meet effluent limitations under R645-301-751 or the applicable Utah and federal water quality standards for the receiving water and an exemption is granted as provided by R645-301-742.240. Powerline corridors crossing disturbed areas either have the surface water runoff report to a sediment pond or other BTCA control structure.
