Dear Mr. Schaeffer:

In a letter dated November 21, 1994, Ms. Deanna Hill of your office notified Puron Corporation (Puron) that their application for license to mine Permit No. 237-T4 was denied due to a bond forfeiture on Permit No. INA007013 belonging to Kaiser Coal Corporation (Kaiser Coal) and Charles S. McNeil. This particular bond forfeiture violation has been a system problem in the Applicant/Violator System (AVS) for over a year. This letter resolves Puron's permit block which currently exists due to the erroneous information regarding the bond status of Kaiser Coal's Permit No. INA007013, and offers suggestions for Wyoming's permit recommendation process so that similar incidents do not occur.

This problem first came to our attention in November of 1993 when an individual associated with Kaiser Coal was permit blocked due to the bond forfeiture on Permit No. INA007013. Subsequent investigation into this matter determined that this bond forfeiture had never occurred but had been entered into the system in error. Please see the enclosed copy of a letter dated December 23, 1993, from the Utah Department of Natural Resources which explains that Permit No. INA007013 was not forfeited. Corrections were made at that time and this bond forfeiture violation was removed from the AVS.

Almost a year later it came to our attention that this violation was again contained in the AVS. We estimate that this violation "reappeared" due to the AVS conversion to a new hardware/software system in October of 1994. In November 1994 we attempted to purge this violation from the new system, but without success due to technical reasons incident to converting to the new system. The problem was then forwarded to our Information Systems Management group who plans to correct this problem over the weekend of February 11 and 12, 1995.


For your information, State Regulatory Authorities normally request an Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) recommendation prior to application processing or permit issuance. Given the changing nature of information in AVS due, in part, to continual data feeds and ongoing investigations and research, there may be a "gap" of information between what is currently contained in the AVS and that which is known to actually exist. Accordingly, as a quality control measure, the AVS office conducts an evaluation of several information sources prior to rendering an OSMRE recommendation. This OSMRE recommendation may sometimes "override" the computer system recommendation due to information that is available to the AVS office that has not yet filtered into the AVS. Therefore, the OSMRE recommendation is the actual recommendation used by the State Regulatory Authorities prior to application processing or permit issuance.

We have no record of Wyoming obtaining an OSMRE recommendation prior to Ms. Hill's November 21st letter. Had an OSMRE recommendation been requested, the status of the Utah bond forfeiture would have been considered and the system "Deny" recommendation would have been overridden to "Issue" by this office.

We regret that the data problems on the bond forfeiture occurred. In the future, we urge that you request an OSM recommendation before officially notifying a company of their status or issuing a permit.

This letter is written pursuant to our conversation today clarifying the status of Kaiser Coal Company's AVS block entered by the State of Utah. Kaiser previously operated the Sunnyside Coal Mine in Utah under permit No. INA/007/013. Although Kaiser Coal Company filed for bankruptcy, the State of Utah did not forfeit Kaiser's bond under this permit. The entry of a permit block for Kaiser Coal Company for bond forfeiture was therefore erroneous.

Kaiser is not presently in violation of the Utah State program and there is no basis for a Utah State permit block on the AVS system. I will ensure that the erroneously entered information will be removed from the AVS system at the earliest possible date. Please contact me if you have further questions.

I am writing to clarify the status of a supposed permit block of Mr. Charles McNeil that until recently was being shown on the Office of Surface Mining's Applicant Violator System ("AVS"). It is my understanding that this permit block was being attributed to Mr. McNeil as a result of his former position as an officer of Kaiser Coal Company, which according to the AVS system had forfeited a bond in Utah in connection with the above-referenced permit.

Kaiser Coal Company previously operated the Sunnyside Coal Company Mine under Utah permit number ACT/007/007. Although Kaiser Coal Company filed for bankruptcy protection, the state of Utah did not forfeit Kaiser's bond under this permit. Instead, Kaiser's bond was replaced with the bond of a successor mine operator, who secured a permit transfer from Utah and assumed all liability for reclamation of the Sunnyside Mine. Kaiser Coal Company and its officers and directors, including Mr. McNeil, were released from liability for reclamation of the mine, with full approval of all concerned regulatory authorities. The bond forfeiture entry in the AVS database, which caused the supposed permit block for Mr. McNeil, was a data entry error. (It should be noted that Kaiser also operated the Horse Canyon Mine under permit number INA/007/013. This permit was not forfeited either.)



In sum, neither Kaiser Coal Company nor Mr. McNeil are in violation of the Utah state program, and there was not, and is not, any basis for a permit block on the AVS system for Mr. McNeil in connection with the Sunnyside Mine, Utah permit number ACT/007/007, nor Utah permit number INA/007/013. Mr. McNeil is eligible to receive a coal mining permit in Utah and, to my knowledge, any other state in the United States.

In a letter dated November 21, 1994, Ms. Deanna Hill of your office notified Puron Corporation (Puron) that their application for license to mine Permit No. 237-T4 was denied due to a bond forfeiture on Permit No. INA007013 belonging to Kaiser Coal Corporation (Kaiser Coal) and Charles S. McNeil. This particular bond forfeiture violation has been a system problem in the Applicant/Violator System (AVS) for over a year. This letter resolves Puron's permit block which currently exists due to the erroneous information regarding the bond status of Kaiser Coal's Permit No. INA007013, and offers suggestions for Wyoming's permit recommendation process so that similar incidents do not occur.

This problem first came to our attention in November of 1993 when an individual associated with Kaiser Coal was permit blocked due to the bond forfeiture on Permit No. INA007013. Subsequent investigation into this matter determined that this bond forfeiture had never occurred but had been entered into the system in error. Please see the enclosed copy of a letter dated December 23, 1993, from the Utah Department of Natural Resources which explains that Permit No. INA007013 was not forfeited. Corrections were made at that time and this bond forfeiture violation was removed from the AVS.

Almost a year later it came to our attention that this violation was again contained in the AVS. We estimate that this violation "reappeared" due to the AVS conversion to a new hardware/software system in October of 1994. In November 1994 we attempted to purge this violation from the new system, but without success due to technical reasons incident to converting to the new system. The problem was then forwarded to our Information Systems Management group who plans to correct this problem over the weekend of February 11 and 12, 1995.

For your information, State Regulatory Authorities normally request an Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) recommendation prior to application processing or permit issuance. Given the changing nature of information in AVS due, in part, to continual data feeds and ongoing investigations and research, there may be a "gap" of information between what is currently contained in the AVS and that which is known to actually exist. Accordingly, as a quality control measure, the AVS office conducts an evaluation of several information sources prior to rendering an OSMRE recommendation. This OSMRE recommendation may sometimes "override" the computer system recommendation due to information that is available to the AVS office that has not yet filtered into the AVS. Therefore, the OSMRE recommendation is the actual recommendation used by the State Regulatory Authorities prior to application processing or permit issuance.

We have no record of Wyoming obtaining an OSMRE recommendation prior to Ms. Hill's November 21st letter. Had an OSMRE recommendation been requested, the status of the Utah bond forfeiture would have been considered and the system "Deny" recommendation would have been overridden to "Issue" by this office.

We regret that the data problems on the bond forfeiture occurred. In the future, we urge that you request an OSM recommendation before officially notifying a company of their status or issuing a permit.



Pursuant to your request, we have undertaken a review of the applicant violator system for Mr. Stonie Barker. Our review has disclosed that Mr. Barker is not in violation of any Utah Law or regulation which would prevent the issuance of a mining permit to an entity with which he is associated. Specifically, Mr. Barker's affiliation with Kaiser Coal Company ("Kaiser") should not act as a permit block. Although Kaiser filed for protection under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, the Kaiser Mine was sold during the reorganization process. The sale included all assets and all liabilities (including Kaiser's reclamation liability). The mine is currently being operated and the mine's reclamation liability is adequately bonded. As such, Kaiser is not presently in violation of any reclamation obligations under state coal laws. This is reflected by the Division's release of Kaiser and its officers and directors from all reclamation liabilities when the mine was sold.

Accordingly, Mr. Stonie Barker is not in violation of any law, rule or regulation under the Utah Coal Program.



Coal plant permits hinge on old violation Utah bond tangle taints Puron official

CASPER — One of the principal corporate officers involved in a plan to build a new coal processing plant near Gillette was involved in 1986 in a Utah coal mining company that went bankrupt and allegedly forfeited the bond put up to cover reclamation costs, federal records show.

Under federal law, that means the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality must deny permits for the proposed coal processing plant until the bond forfeiture issue is resolved.

DEQ officials have notified the corporate sponsors of the plant of that result — and of the fact that it is the DEQ's policy not to investigate the nature of the violation.

Rather, it is the company's responsibility to clear up the matter with federal officials, who will then notify the DEQ.

Environmentalists, meanwhile, cited the questions about the corporate officer's prior violations as a substantial reason to slow down what state officials have acknowledged has been a very accelerated permit approval process for the proposed new coal processing plant.

Similarly, an apparent desire of the Laramie-based Puron Corporation to withhold information about its corporate structure from the public also suggests good reason for the state to step back from the accelerated permit process, environmental groups say.

The proposed \$400 million plant is a joint venture of the Kennecott Energy Company and Puron which has licensed its coal drying technology to Kennecott.

The coal drying plant would create a high heat value, low-sulfur coal.

fur briquette. State and industry officials have for years had high hopes that coal enhancement technology could add value to Wyoming's vast coal reserves and boost the economy.

Officials with both Kennecott and Puron either declined to comment or would not return repeated phone calls regarding the bond violation issue and their desire to withhold information from the public.

Federal screening system

The bond forfeiture issue turned up during a routine computer check of the federal Applicant Violator System, a screening system operated by the federal Office of Surface Mining to review permit applicants, DEQ documents show.

The AVS is a data base of previous regulatory infractions through which federal law requires that the names of the corporate officers of any new mining-related venture be run.

Federal law mandates that if a corporate officer's record shows an infraction as serious as a bond forfeiture, the company cannot get a permit for a new venture.

Kennecott and Puron have applied for air quality and land quality permits, as well as for fast-track siting approval from the state Industrial Siting Council.

In a letter dated Nov. 21, DEQ Bonding Analyst Deanna Hill informed Puron co-owner Joseph Vallancourt that the AVS check generated a recommendation that Puron's permit be denied because the routine records check connected the other co-owner, Charles McNeil, with a violation for reclamation bond forfeiture in Utah.

The alleged bond forfeiture occurred in 1986 in connection with Utah's Sunnyside Mine, when McNeil was one of the officers of mine owner Kaiser Coal Corporation.

The letter was obtained by the Powder River Basin Resource Council from DEQ permitting records in Sheridan.

According to Rick Chancellor of the DEQ's Land Quality Division, the violation remains unresolved and the division's "deny" recommendation resulting from the violation remains in place.

In the case of a bond forfeiture, Chancellor said, the DEQ cannot by federal law issue a permit until the forfeiture is resolved. He said that the DEQ relies completely on the AVS system to notify it when the matter is resolved, and does not conduct an investigation of its own.

"It usually involves other states, so we let the (applicant) contact the other state and contact the clearinghouse, and if they can they resolve the problem," he said.

If the company can demonstrate to the federal Office of Surface Mining that it is making progress toward reclaiming a site or addressing the specified problem, a permit may also be granted, Chancellor said. But OSM,

not DEQ, makes the decision, he said.

Utah situation

Joe Helfrich, a permit supervisor with the Utah Department of Natural Resources, said this week that in fact there was no bond forfeiture. Helfrich said that McNeil's former company, Kaiser Coal, filed for bankruptcy in 1986 and sold the development rights to the property in question.

The OSM and the State of Utah allowed Kaiser to transfer its reclamation responsibilities to the purchasing corporation, though it potentially could have been held responsible for reclaiming the site, he said.

The company which purchased the rights from Kaiser has now gone bankrupt, Helfrich said, leaving the State of Utah to litigate with it over reclamation.

According to Donna Griffin, with the OSM's Albuquerque office, attorneys for Chase Manhattan bank became involved in the negotiations because the bank was backing some of Kaiser's liabilities.

Griffin said that Kaiser was self-bonded for the mine, but a takeover attempt caused the company's financial health to deteriorate.

"In the infighting that occurred on the board, including Charles McNeil ... who got hurt was all the miners. Kaiser robbed its pension fund," she said, while stressing that she had no way to estimate if McNeil was involved in that.

"In order to get Kaiser and themselves totally released from any reclamation liability, there were all these agreements with this new buyer, even though the buyer didn't have the capability to put up the reclamation bond," she said. "You just never know about these corporate things."

Griffin said that the transfer allowed the mine to stay open for another five years, but that in the latest bankruptcy, Sunnyside mine buyer David Korman "has slipped out the door" owing money.

Korman was allowed to post a \$3 million reclamation bond, but Griffin said that most of the bond was tied up in real estate collateral. When the OSM investigated later, "We determined that it should have been about a \$8 million bond," she said.

Griffin also said that when Kaiser filed for bankruptcy, it owed the federal government about \$200,000 in Abandoned Mine Land payments.

"This shows you how these people end up with money in their pockets but nothing to give to their workers ... Kaiser did leave the coal fields owing the government money," she said, adding that the \$200,000 was eventually paid by another member of the board who wanted to mine at another site in the east.

McNeil did not return several messages this week.

Jill Morrison of the Powder River Basin Resource Council said the fact that the Utah mine site has yet to be reclaimed is discouraging. She argued that it

is possible that McNeil and the other officers of Kaiser Coal were allowed to walk away from their responsibilities in Utah.

"It doesn't really bode well, in terms of who are we allowing to come and do business in Wyoming," she said.

Confidentiality request

As part of the computer background search, Vallancourt provided the DEQ with the names of the owners, officers, controllers and directors of the Puron Corporation in the Nov. 16 letter.

Though he provided the requested information, Vallancourt asked the DEQ to keep those names from the public.

"Puron requests that this information be kept confidential and be used only for the background search and not to be released to the public in any matter," he wrote.

His request was ultimately denied by the DEQ, though the agency solicited an opinion from the secretary of state's office to see if it could be legally granted.

Hill's Nov. 21 letter to Vallancourt also advised that the request for secrecy could only be granted under state statute if divulging the names of corporate officers would somehow reveal trade secrets.

"Please provide us with sufficient evidence that divulging of this information is a trade secret," Hill wrote.

Evidently, the company could not demonstrate this, because the letter became part of the public record for the application.

Contacted Tuesday, Puron's Vallancourt referred all questions from the press to Lyle Randen, the Kennecott official in charge of the project.

"If I want to keep my job, I have to go through Lyle," Vallancourt said.

Randen also did not return messages left at his office this week.

The PRBRC's Bob Strayer said last week, "What are they hiding? I think this is just one of many reasons to slow down the process and take a closer look at their application."

"I think it's very disturbing that they're asking the state for fast-track permitting, when they don't even want the people of the state to know who they are," Strayer added.

DEQ Director Dennis Hemmer said last week that it was no concern of his agency if Puron wanted to keep its corporate officers secret.

"Our test is not some perception of the company. Our test is whether they've complied with the law," Hemmer said.





This firm represents Clay and Daniel Tucker and related family members (collectively "Tuckers") in connection with their acquisition, through a to-be-formed Utah limited liability corporation, Whitmore, L.C., of certain property and water right assets ("Assets"), including substantially all of the Sunnyside Coal Mine, from the bankruptcy estate of the Sunnyside Coal Company ("Debtor") (the "Transaction"). As you know, the Debtor holds a permit to conduct surface coal mining and reclamation operations, number ACT/007/007, and also is subject to Order 94B, issued July 7, 1994. The purpose of this letter is to request confirmation by the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining ("DOGM" or the "Division") and the Office of Surface Mining ("OSM") of certain effects of the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act, Utah Code Ann. § 40-10-1 *et seq.* and the Division's Coal Mining Rules, Utah Admin. Code R645, and corresponding federal laws and regulations, on the Transaction. An executed copy of a Letter of Intent describing the Transaction has been provided to DOGM's counsel, Thomas A. Mitchell and OSM's counsel, Robert Clark.

If the Transaction is approved by the Bankruptcy Court by a final, non-appealable order, free and clear of all liens, claims and interests, the Tuckers are prepared to assume the reclamation obligation for the lands presently subject to permit ACT/007/007.

In connection with the Transaction the Tuckers do not intend to conduct any surface coal mining operations, as defined in the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Act, and do not intend to acquire DOGM permit ACT/007/007 or any rights granted thereunder. Accordingly, the Tuckers understand that the requirement for prior Division approval of transfer, assignment, or sale of the rights granted under permit ACT/007/007 pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 40-10-12(2) and Utah Admin. Code R645-303-300 (and corresponding federal laws and regulations) are inapplicable to the Transaction. I would appreciate confirmation by the Division and the OSM of this understanding.

Cognizant that there are outstanding and unfulfilled reclamation obligations at the Sunnyside mine, the Tuckers are prepared to submit an application for approval of a reclamation plan which meets the approval requirements of R645-303-340, including a performance bond or other acceptable surety in the amount of \$8.6 million (the "Bond"). The Tuckers propose to present the Bond to the Division at the closing of the Transaction, in accord and satisfaction of all liens, bonds and other claims and encumbrances (collectively "Claims") which the Division and the OSM have or may have against the Assets. The Tuckers request confirmation that, upon presentation of the Bond at closing, including a commitment to comply with R645-303-321 *et seq.* (except the requirements to provide an application for approval, and to obtain approval, of a transfer, assignment or sale of rights granted by a permit), and signing of an appropriate reclamation agreement, the Division and the OSM shall fully release the Claims and quitclaim to the estate of the Debtor any property interests which they hold in the Assets. To the extent that the OSM has asserted a claim against the Debtor for unpaid AML fees, that claim does not affect the Assets or the release by OSM of the Claims against the Assets.

The Tuckers also contemplate entering an agreement with the cities of Sunnyside and East Carbon ("Cities") respecting certain of the Assets. If this agreement is reached and closed, Tuckers would convey to one or both of the Cities any interest the Tuckers acquire from the Debtor in (1) the Grassy Creek Dam and Reservoir and appurtenant works, (2) a well known as Well 90-1, plus necessary access, water line and power line easements. The agreement would provide that the Cities assume any reclamation obligations associated with these properties.
