As a follow-up to meetings held on 3-14 and 3-16, I believe the activities listed on this memo need to be accomplished before the signing of any reclamation agreement by Tucker. I've taken the liberty of making a few assignments and establishing some time frames for performance. There may be additional items that need to be done prior to early April. Please feel free to discuss these with me. We will need to update this list after the signing with Tucker. Please assemble these additional needs and wants and let me know...

1. Establish legal description for Tucker reclamation agreement.
 - a. Field verification of disturbed area: Randy Harden, Joe Helfrich, Pete Hess, Henry Sauer, week of 3-27.
 - b. Keep B Canyon portals in reclamation agreement. File research for justification: Pam Grubaugh-Littig, week of 3-20.
 - c. Remove Grassy Trail Reservoir from reclamation agreement area. File research for justification: Pam Grubaugh-Littig, week of 3-20.
 - d. Remove shared permit (SCA/SCC) from Tucker reclamation agreement. Legal basis: Tom Mitchell/John Andrews, week of 3-27.
 - e. Legal basis for cleanup activities not constituting mining (for basis of AML payments, etc.): Tom Mitchell, week of 3-27.
2. Need document to terminate Sunnyside MRP effective date of Tucker reclamation agreement (may be part of Tucker reclamation agreement at this time, otherwise Tom Mitchell, week of 3-27).



3. Locate portal closures map generated by SCC 1994: Pam Grubaugh-Littig's office??
 - a. Establish schedule for ground verification of portals. (Consider as partial inspections)?: Joe Helfrich, week of 3-27.
4. Establish and negotiate monthly schedule of approved cleanup and demo activity for:
 - a. April, May, June '95.
 - b. Quarterly to follow: Randy Harden/Joe Helfrich/Pete Hess by _____?
 - c. Establish Division field contact with decision authority for cleanup.
 - d. Establish Tucker field contact with decision authority.
5. Establish review team for reclamation agreement: Daron Haddock, Randy Harden, Joe Helfrich, week of 3-27.
6. Establish list of "inspectables" for Tucker reclamation agreement: Joe Helfrich, Henry Sauer, week of 3-27.
 - a. Includes monitoring requirements, review of papers, etc.
 - b. Courtesy inspection? Joe Helfrich.
7. Consolidate Tom Mitchell's and Jim Carter's files to ensure an accurate record exists for Central Files: Pam Grubaugh-Littig, week of 3-20.

Subject: Sunnyside Acreage

I have reviewed the Sunnyside Mine maps and have determined that significant acreage besides the acreage under permit to Sunnyside Cogeneration is missing from the legal description attached to the Reclamation Agreement. This is substantiated by the fact that the bonded area attached to the Agreement is 11,430 acres and the permit area in the 1991 permit application package is 14,520 acres. The missing acreage is described as:

Township 14S Range 14E

- Res.*
- Section 6, all except NE 1/4 SE 1/4
 - Section 7, W1/2, SE1/4 NE1/4, NW1/4 SE1/4, S1/2 SE1/4
 - Section 8, SW 1/4, SW 1/4, SE 1/4

Section 18, NW1/4 NW1/4, NE1/4 NW 1/4, Part of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4.
Additionally the bonded area lists part of the SE1/4 NW1/4 and NW1/4 NE1/4 when in fact it should be the entire quarter-quarter sections.

Township 14S Range 13E

Section 1, SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4.

Res. Section 12, NE1/4, NW 1/4 SE1/4, NE 1/4 SE1/4, SE1/4 SE1/4, part of the SW1/4 SE1/4, E1/2 NW 1/4, part of the W1/2 NW1/4, part of the NE1/4 SW1/4.

Section 13, part of NE1/4 NE1/4, part of the W1/2.

Section 14, part of NE 1/4

Section 11, part of SW1/4 SE1/4

Section 24, part of NE1/4 SW 1/4

Township 15 S, Range 14E

Section 15, E1/2 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, N 1/2 NE 1/4

Section 10, E 1/2.

Section 3, SE 1/4, S1/2 NE 1/4.

As you know each section is 640 acres, each 1/4 is 160 acres, each 1/4 1/4 is 40 acres, so you can see why there is a significant difference between the two figures.

This acreage does not include Sunnyside Cogen which is in Sections 6 and 7 of T15S, R14E.
