**NOTICE PURSUANT TO LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 202 OF FINAL APPLICATION BY HOLLAND & HART, ATTORNEYS FOR THE DEBTOR, FOR THE ALLOWANCE AND PAYMENT OF ATTORNEYS' FEES AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 330 AND BANKRUPTCY RULE 2016(a)**

TO ALL PARTIES IN INTEREST:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the movant named below has applied to this Court or is intending to take action as follows: Holland & Hart, attorneys for the Debtor, Sunnyside Coal Company, has applied to the Court for final allowance and payment of attorneys' fees and reimbursement of expenses for the period from the commencement of the case on March 25, 1994 through June 30, 1996, in the amount of \$393,663 in fees (including \$129,058 previously allowed on an interim basis) and \$22,053.88 in expenses (including \$16,235.97 previously allowed on an interim basis). Holland & Hart has previously been paid \$6,200.47 of the amounts requested. A copy of the pleading is available for inspection in the Bankruptcy Court Clerk's Office, or upon request from the undersigned attorney.

Pursuant to Rule 202 of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, if you desire to oppose this action you must file a written objection and request for a hearing with the Court on or before September 9, 1996, and serve a copy thereof on the undersigned attorney. Objections and requests for hearing shall clearly specify the grounds upon which they are based, including the citation of supporting legal authority, if any. General objections will not be considered by the Court.

In the absence of a timely and substantiated objection and request for hearing by an interested party, the court may approve or grant the aforementioned application without any further notice to creditors or other interested parties.
