9. PROTECTION OF FISH, WILDLIFE AND RELATED ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES

Overall, conditions at the site remain unchanged. Several of the existing silt fences have deteriorated to the point that they are ineffective. Any gullies which previously existed have become larger. The site was barren of snow as of the date of this inspection. Fresh ORV tracks were noted around the spoil pile which is just west of the Sunnyside Surface Facilities pond, UPDES #014.
