
Enclosed is a copy of the rules pertaining to a change in post-mining land use (PMLU) and a draft guide to applying for a PMLU.

Please be mindful of the items we discussed concerning a change in PMLU. They were: 1) asbestos abatement on any buildings remaining, needs to be addressed; 2) hazardous material cleanup on any areas left unreclaimed, needs to be addressed; and 3) costs for reclamation design changes, to leave areas and buildings unreclaimed, will be borne by the PMLU applicant.

Earlier this year, COVOL made a submittal to this Division applying for a PMLU. The application was denied based on its inadequacy. Hopefully, this draft guide will be helpful in a resubmittal.
